An act relating to public contracts.

LEGISLATIVE COUNSEL'S DIGEST

AB 1651, as introduced, Garcia. Public contracts: California workers.

Existing law requires public entities to comply with certain procedures in soliciting and awarding public contracts.

This bill would declare the Legislature's intent to enact legislation that will encourage public entities to procure goods and services from businesses that employ California workers.

Vote: majority. Appropriation: no. Fiscal committee: no. State-mandated local program: no.

The people of the State of California do enact as follows:

- 2 enact legislation that will encourage public entities to procure
- 3 goods and services from businesses that employ California
- 4 workers.
